

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
APRIL 7, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, April 7, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Commissioner Jordan. Vice-Chairman Jernigan led the pledge of allegiance.

Vice-Chairman Jernigan called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Agenda**

Vice-Chairman Jernigan stated the Agenda needed to be amended; Mr. Chappell will be presenting for the Planning Director and the Inspection Supervisor; Commissioner Askew would like to be added to the Agenda and the Board will need to enter into Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143.318.11(a)(3)(6) before adjourning.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to approve the amended Agenda. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Jordan made the motion to approve the Minutes of the March 3, March 15, and March 25 Minutes as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Department Reports**

Sharon Harrell, Register of Deeds, presented Budget Amendment 57.

Mr. Chappell presented Budget Amendment 58 – 60.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 57 – 60 as presented. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the February Tax Collector's Report.

Commissioner Jordan requested an itemized list of refunds made by the Tax Department be provided to the Board in the future.

Patrice Lassiter, GITS Director, presented the Community Transportation Program Grant.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the Community Transportation Grant. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

There being no comments from the citizens Commissioner Jordan made a motion to close the Public Hearing for the Community Transportation Grant. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to adopt the Resolution to apply for Community Transportation Program funding. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Old Business**

Timmy Hedgepeth presented a proposal for bi-monthly water meter reading and billing.

Commissioner Jordan requested Mr. Hedgepeth put in writing a new cut-off schedule to accompany the proposed bi-monthly schedule.

Ashley Taylor, Gatesville, requested citizens be notified after the first delinquent water payment.

Vice-Chairman Jernigan requested Mr. Hedgepeth implement the suggested cost-saving measure of two-man per truck for meter reading and report the results to the Board.

Commissioner Askew commended Mr. Hedgepeth for trying to implement cost saving measures for the Water Department and the citizens, but due to the current economic status, the implementation would be better at another time.

John Hora, Eure, suggested a water bill pre-payment system.

Commissioner Jordan questioned the possibility of having an automatic monthly bank draft plan.

Mrs. McGinnis stated she would investigate this concern with the current software system and report back to the Board next month.

Ashley Taylor, Gatesville, commended Mr. Hedgepeth for trying to implement a cost saving policy.

Mr. Chappell stated the \$1,000 Cash Bond for Temporary Certificate of Occupancy is still being reviewed by Edgar Mitchell, Building Inspector.

Mr. Chappell presented the Transition Plan for the Child Support Enforcement Program.

#### **New Business**

Robert Jordan, School Resource Officer, stated he meets with the Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD). The organization would like to have a teen curfew implemented. He presented a petition with 300 student signatures supporting a teen curfew.

Commissioner Jordan suggested holding a Town Hall Meeting between SADD and the Commissioners to discuss their concerns. Officer Jordan will follow up on this matter.

Darlene Harrell, Senior Nutrition Director, Albemarle Commission, presented the Albemarle Commissions' Senior Nutrition Program Agreement. The agreement covers the employee who monitors the senior meal site at the community center. Ms. Harrell is unable to supervise each employee in this position at each site. She is requesting to have this position supervised by local personnel. This employee would become a County employee funded by the Albemarle Commission for \$9.00/hour, four (4) hours/day.

This item will be tabled until the May Board Meeting.

Vice-Chairman Jernigan called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

Roy Wilson, Area Director, and Joy Futrell, Finance Officer, East Carolina Behavioral Health, presented the Annual Report.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to support East Carolina Behavioral Health in applying to operate the Medicaid funded behavioral health services for consumers through a capitated Pre-paid Inpatient Health Plan. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Ray Scaffa, Acting President of College of the Albemarle, gave a statistical presentation on County residents attending COA.

George Brite, Past President and Secretary of the Albemarle Area Association of Realtors was unable to attend. Mr. Chappell presented a Proclamation for proclaiming April as Fair Housing Month.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adopt the Proclamation proclaiming April as Fair Housing Month. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Proclamation reads as follows:

**PROCLAMATION  
FOR  
FAIR HOUSING MONTH  
APRIL 2010**

**WHEREAS**, April 2010 marks the 42nd anniversary of the Federal Housing Act of 1968 and the 27th anniversary of the North Carolina Fair Housing Act. Both laws prohibit discrimination in housing because of race, color, sex, religion, national origin, handicap and familial status; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gates County Board of Commissioners, Albemarle Area Association of Realtors, City of Elizabeth City, Elizabeth City State University Community Development Program, North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service Pasquotank Center, Northeastern Community Development Corporation, and River City Community Development Corporation, and county and local governments, concerned citizens and the housing industry, are working to make fair housing opportunities possible for all our citizens. Through their efforts, they are encouraging others to abide by the letter and the spirit of the fair housing laws; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the most important concerns of the citizens of Gates County is the availability of housing to them as individuals and families. By supporting and promoting fair housing and equal opportunity, we are contributing to the health of our County and our State;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Gates County Board of Commissioners, do hereby proclaim April 2010 as **"Fair Housing Month"** in Gates County and urge our citizens to rededicate themselves to ensuring that fair housing laws are always upheld and citizens are protected against discrimination.

Vice-Chairman Jernigan presented a Resolution to Support the Opening of Chowan Swamp Game Lands.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adopt the Resolution to Support the Opening of Chowan Swamp Game Lands as submitted. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION  
TO  
SUPPORT THE OPENING OF CHOWAN SWAMP GAME LANDS**

**Whereas,** Gates County residents have historically had access to the Chowan Swamp Game Lands, specifically as it relates to the areas commonly known as Gatlington Landing and Dowry Landing; and

**Whereas,** The makeup of these facilities, being some of the few sandy areas in Gates County on the Chowan River, lends themselves to various groups including church groups, boaters, and swimmers using this facility for perfectly lawful religious and recreational purposes; and

**Whereas,** It has come to the attention of the Gates County Board of Commissioners that access to these facilities has been abridged via locked gates; and

**Whereas,** The Gates County Board of Commissioners believe that the access to these facilities should be granted in a manner that is able to curtail illegal activities all the while not hindering lawful uses.

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** that the Gates County Board of Commissioners:

1. Strongly oppose the continued unfettered restriction to access at these facilities.
2. Wish to encourage all stakeholders; citizens, law enforcement, the State of North Carolina, et. al to join together to arrive at an amicable solution to the problem.
3. Specifically, the Gates County Board of Commissioners asks that this facility be reopened in a manner that is consistent with the lawful uses of same.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
