

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
EMERGENCY MEETING  
MAY 14, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in an Emergency Teleconference Meeting on Friday, May 14, 2010 at 9:07 a.m. in the County Manager's Office, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Askew and Jordan were present via phone. Commissioner Nickens could not be located. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell.

Chairman Twine called the Emergency Teleconference Meeting to order. The purpose of the meeting was to authorize the donation of surplus office equipment to the Graham County Sheriff's Office in accordance with NCGS 160A-274. A truck with donations from northeastern North Carolina will be leaving Rocky Mount at 11:00 a.m. Our donated items need to be in Rocky Mount at that time. The surplus office equipment to be donated is: 4 desks, 6 chairs, 1-five drawer filing cabinet, 2 4-drawer filing cabinets and 1 coat rack. On May 10, 2010 the Graham County Sheriff's Office was completely destroyed by fire set by an arsonist.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to donate surplus office equipment to the Graham County Sheriff's Department in accordance with NCGS 160A-274. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion. Chairman Twine, Commissioners Jordan, Jernigan and Askew signified their vote by saying "yes" individually. Motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
