

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 3, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, March 3, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens, and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Rev. Roger Kiker. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Twine stated the following amendments need to be made to the Agenda: Budget Amendments will be presented by the head of each respective department, Linda Eure, Deputy Tax Collector will be presenting for Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor and the Gates County Department of Correction Wastewater Treatment Facility Change of Ownership has been canceled.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the Agenda with amendments. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the February 3 and February 17 meeting minutes as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Department Reports

Colleen Turner, Department of Social Services Director, presented Budget Amendments 52-55. Toby Chappell presented Budget Amendment 56.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 52-56 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Linda Eure, Deputy Tax Collector, presented the December and January Tax Collector's Report.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to schedule the first Board of Equalization and Review Meeting at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 per NCGS 105-322(e). Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Eure presented the total amount of unpaid taxes for the 2009-2010 fiscal year that are liens on real property:

As per NCGS 105-369(a), upon receipt of this report the governing body must order the Tax Collector to advertise the tax liens.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to order the Tax Collector to advertise the tax liens for the unpaid taxes for the 2009-2010 fiscal year. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Turner presented the Annual Report for the Gates County Community Child Protection Team and Child Fatality Prevention Team on Child Welfare issues in the

County. Along with asking the Board to accept the Annual Report she also requested to appoint Dianne Taylor, Uplift, to the Team.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the Gates County Community Child Protection Team and Child Fatality Prevention Team on Child Welfare and to appoint Dianne Taylor to the Team. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Turner also provided a Child Care update.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented the Proposed Parent Parcel Subdivision Ordinance text change.

Ms. Jethro also presented the Proposed Family Land Transfer Ordinance text change.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the Proposed Parent Parcel Family Land Transfer Ordinance text change. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Dan Bazemore, Eure, requested the wording to include adopted children and grandchildren.

Linda Hofler, Planning Board Chairperson, stated an adopted child is a legal lineage; an appeals process was included to serve as a grievance if needed.

Sandra Nickens, Gatesville, stated she thought as a property owner one could give their land to anyone they wanted to.

Ms. Hofler stated this ordinance is to make it easier for families to give property to family members.

Mr. Godwin stated the Commissioners could change the text they wish today.

Joe Green, Planning Board member, asked the Commissioners to make the text changes as they wish and pass this today; the Planning Board has worked on this project for three (3) months.

John Hora, Eure, stated his concern would be with the State exercising the right of imminent domain, would there be individual parcels instead of one parcel.

Mr. Godwin stated unless the deed changed, there would still be one parent parcel.

Thomas Langston, Planning Board member, requested public hearings be held at night rather than during the day.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

Ms. Jethro presented the amended text change to the ordinance:

Parent Parcel – a parent parcel begins at the date of adoption of the Gates County Subdivision Ordinance of April 5, 2004, and is the original parcel or tract of land in existence prior to any division of the parcel ~~has occurred~~. Any division of the parent parcel shall comply with the Gates County Subdivision Ordinance.

H. The division of land by any method of transfer from a grantor to a grantee (or grantees) who is a member of the grantor's immediate family, solely for the residential use of the grantee (or grantees) for as long as the use is appropriate under local ordinances. For the purposes of this subdivision, the term "immediate family" includes only direct lineal descendants within (children and grandchildren) and direct lineal ascendants (parents and grandparents), as well as adopted and step relationships. Division of land in this category must have access to an established public or private right-of-way or an easement for ingress and egress. The burden of

proof of kinship shall be placed on the subdivider, and must provide a notarized copy of a birth certificate to the Subdivision Administrator. After conveyance of the parcel, the property must be owned for a minimum of two years by the grantee (or grantees) before further transfer.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the amended text change to the Parent Parcel/Family Land Transfer Ordinance. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Edgar Mitchell, Inspection Department Director, presented a request to change the cash bond amount to \$1,000 in the Application for Temporary Certificate Occupancy (C-O).

Commissioner Jordan stated he preferred to see daily penalties levied rather than cutting off the power. He suggested to table this concern, have the Building Inspector and County Manager review and return to the Board at the April meeting.

Timmy Hedgepeth, Water Department Supervisor, presented a proposal for bi-monthly water meter reading and billing.

Chairman Twine asked the newspaper editor to print an article notifying citizens of a proposed billing change and to have public meetings at the next two Board meetings to get citizen input.

Old Business

Mr. Chappell presented a contract from YoungWilliams for Child Support Enforcement Services.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the contract once typographical errors were corrected. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine stated three citizens have stated an interest in serving as the at large member on the Albemarle Commission Board, Sandra Nickens, MacArthur Britt and Wesley Boone

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to open the floor for nominations. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan nominated Wesley Boone. Commissioner Nickens nominated Sandra Nickens.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to close the nominations. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens voted for Sandra Nickens. Chairman Twine, Commissioners Jernigan, Askew and Jordan voted for Wesley Boone. Wesley Boone will be appointed as the at large member to the Albemarle Commission Board by a majority vote.

Commissioner Askew presented a letter addressed to the Department of Transportation requesting a study be conducted to have the speed limit set at 45 mph for the entire distance of the White Oak Road.

Commissioner Nickens made the motion to forward the letter to the Department of Transportation. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew also mentioned the highway in front of the Roduco convenience site needs a double yellow line for safety purposes. He will bring a letter with the request to the Board of consideration.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

Mr. Chappell presented a contract for Martin Starnes and Associates, CPAs, P.A. for audit services. The second contract has increased \$650 to \$44,300.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to accept the contract from Martin Starnes and Associates, CPAs, P.A. for audit services. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented changes to the Gates County Personnel Ordinance for the Boards' consideration. The changes will be discussed at the March 15, 2010 meeting. He also presented the Operating Instruction for Compensatory Time. It will be added to the Personnel Ordinance as an addendum.

Mr. Chappell presented the broadband concern for the County. Through stimulus funds, broadband will be made available to areas of the County that have not been accessible before. He also presented a resolution promoting a focus on deployment, adoption, and usage of broadband applications in unserved and underserved areas.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adopt the resolution and sign a letter of support promoting the broadband concerns of the County. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution reads as follows:

RESOLUTION

Broadband Access in Unserved and Underserved Areas within North Carolina Counties

To promote a focus on deployment, adoption, and usage of broadband applications in unserved and underserved areas within North Carolina counties.

WHEREAS, broadband networks provide solutions to critical educational, public safety and social challenges, and will provide economically disadvantaged communities access to vital quality of life opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, through National Telecommunications and Information Administration's (NTIA) Comprehensive Community Infrastructure Program, provides ample funding for such pro-broadband deployment programs as middle mile connectivity, and creates additional demands for broadband technologies through the establishment of public computing centers which foster community education and access, both critical for strengthening the North Carolina communities; and

WHEREAS, local governments seek to provide their communities with the capacity for high-quality and affordable communications services in order to enhance economic development, increase educational opportunities, and improve governmental transparency and accountability; and

WHEREAS, the Gates County Board of Commissioners recognize that expanding broadband access and services in unserved and underserved areas will stimulate new services offerings such as digital literacy, digital community engagement and distance education offerings; and

WHEREAS, the Gates County Board of Commissioners seek to ensure that our community is prepared to meet the technological challenges, by supporting the

development and implementation of public-private broadband deployment partnerships, regardless of geography, socio-economic status, age, and physical ability; and

Now, therefore, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Gates County Board of Commissioners applaud and support the North Carolina Rural Broadband Initiative, led by MCNC, for its efforts to recognize the importance of ensuring availability of broadband infrastructure and promoting adoption and usage of broadband applications, products, services, in the unserved and underserved counties in North Carolina; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Gates County Board of Commissioners request the NTIA strongly consider the North Carolina Rural Broadband Initiative as the highest priority for the state of North Carolina and its unserved and underserved communities.
