

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 2, 2011**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, February 2, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Hora, Owens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell.

A prayer was led by Commissioner Jordan. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Agenda**

Chairman Twine stated Commissioner Jordan will be added to the Agenda as New Business D. Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Agenda as amended. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 5 and January 19 Commissioners' Meetings as amended. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Citizen Comments**

Dan Bazemore, Eure, questioned the status of the no passing lines at the convenience sites. Chairman Twine stated he will follow-up with the Dept. of Transportation. Mr. Bazemore questioned the status of the Hwy 13/158 widening project. Chairman Twine provided an update. Mr. Bazemore stated dilapidated/burned houses in the County are not meeting code and action needs to be taken. Chairman Twine stated this topic has been discussed previously and will be discussed during budget session due to finances being involved.

Wade Askew, Eure, commented on the freedom of speech.

Thomas Langston, Gates, reported on a trailer connected to temporary service for more than 180 days.

**Department Reports**

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 35, 40 - 44.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 35, 40 - 44 as modified. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the January Tax Collector's Report, a form to be used for a Payment Plan for Delinquent Tax and discussed the collection of minimal taxes and small underpayments and overpayments and provided resolutions to cover each.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to move forward with the resolutions pending attorney opinion. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, stated the County does not have any minimum setbacks established for lots that were created prior to the first development ordinance (December 1985).

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to open the Public Hearing on the Proposed Text Amendment on Variance for Prior Lots of Record. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Carolyn Riddick, Eure, requested the 120 day replacement time be extended.

Dan Bazemore, Eure, stated he supported the text change but wanted the statement for pre-existing structures to be included.

Thomas Langston, Gates, stated action needs to be taken to correct the variance issue.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The consensus of the Board was to send the text amendment back to the Planning Board for review.

Ms. Jethro discussed a text amendment regarding the percent of space of a dwelling that can be utilized for a home occupation. The Planning Board currently recommends 25% instead of 49%.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the text amendment regarding the amount of space of a dwelling that can be utilized for a home occupation. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Joe Greene, Eure, Planning Board member, stated when this was discussed previously with the Planning Board the home owner could be the only employee, with the new proposal four (4) employees would be allowed; he urged the Board to remember this would be in a residential area.

Lee Riddick, Gatesville, questioned how the property for a home business would be taxed. Chairman Twine explained the property would be taxed according to the way it was zoned.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The consensus of the Board was to return the text amendment change to the Planning Board for further review.

Ms. Jethro, presented for Carolyn Morris, the CDBG Language Access Approval. The County Manager will discuss the Policy with Mrs. Morris for clarification.

The Chairman called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

#### **Old Business**

Chairman Twine discussed the lapsed appointments to the ABC Board.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to retroactively appoint ABC Board members and reappoint Perry Eure to an additional three-year term, July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2012 and reappoint G. P. Kittrell to a three-year term July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

#### **New Business**

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to recognize the Facility Needs Survey has been received from Gates County Schools. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell discussed the text change to the County's Inclement Weather Policy.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept the text change to the County's Inclement Weather Policy as presented and it to be effective February 3, 2011.

Commissioner Jordan discussed the text change to the Compensatory Time Policy.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Compensatory Time Policy as presented. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Commissioner Comments**

Chairman Twine discussed the policy for getting on the Commissioners' agenda. The policy will be reviewed and placed on the March 2 agenda.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to enter into Closed Session authorized by NCGS 143-318.11.(a)(3)(6). Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Memorandum of Understanding as presented upon approval of the County's attorney. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.


