

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 4, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, August 4, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Rev. Eugene Fields. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Agenda as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the July 2, 7 and 19 Meeting Minutes as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Department Reports

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the July Tax Collector's Report. She also presented a request for a taxpayer refund for E. P. Boone, \$358.86

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve a refund to taxpayer, E. P. Boone, for \$358.86. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Reba Greene-Holley, Extension Director, presented Budget Amendments 5-8, 10 and 11.

Mr. Chappell, County Manager, presented Budget Amendments 4 and 9.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 4-11 as presented. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented a Preliminary Plat Approval request for Rose and Bruce Lee. The Planning Board had approved the Preliminary Plat as presented. Commissioner Jernigan requested to be recused and leave the meeting.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Commissioner Jernigan's request. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the Preliminary Plat Approval for Rose and Bruce Lee. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

J. E. Harrell, Gates, commented it would be a travesty to have Mr. and Mrs. Lee construct and pave a new drive on a 175 year old farm.

Chuck Brothers, Planning Board Member, stated the Planning Board was in agreement.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the Preliminary Plat approval for Rose and Bruce Lee. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan returned to the meeting.

Ms. Jethro presented a Preliminary Plat approval request for Merchants Commerce Center for Kim Old. The Planning Board had conditionally approved the Preliminary Plat as presented.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the Preliminary Plat request for the Merchants Commerce Center for Kim Old. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

J. E. Harrell, Gates, commented he was cautiously excited about the development and wanted to know who was in control of developing the area and bringing in businesses.

Chairman Twine replied the developer would be selling the property.

Jack Owens, Chamber of Commerce Chairman, stated Merchants Commerce Center is a great opportunity for the County and wants to see it developed correctly and esthetically.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to close the Public Hearing on the Merchants Commerce Center. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the conditional Preliminary Plat Approval for the Merchants Commerce Center for Kim Old. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Ms. Morgan presented the 2010 Hazard Mitigation Plan. It is reviewed every five (5) years per FEMA request.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the 2010 Hazard Mitigation Plan and have it forwarded to FEMA. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Old Business

Mr. Chappell presented a CDBG contract amendment. The existing contract is not aligned with the grant award. The Albemarle Commission is responsible for Planning and Administering for a fee of \$47,000. The current contract states \$38,958 has been appropriated for Planning and Administration. The contract needs to be amended between the Albemarle Commission and the County.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion for Mr. Chappell to inform Mr. Bert Banks, Albemarle Commission Director, the County will follow the agreement made at the June 18 Commissioners' Meeting: the third and fourth houses will be bid together; the fourth house will not be started until the third house has been completed and the additional funds will be paid to the Albemarle Commission for planning and administration only if the funds are available. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

New Business

Mr. Chappell presented a Memorandum of Agreement between the County of Gates and NC Wildlife Resources Commission to work cooperatively to implement a pilot program to provide public access to the Chowan River on Chowan Swamp Game Land at Ray's Beach, Dowry and Gatlington Roads.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion not to accept the Memorandum of Agreement between the County of Gates and NC Wildlife Resources Commission. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented a Gates County Medical Transportation Service Permitting Ordinance.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to table the Ordinance until the September 1 Commissioners' Meeting. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Timmy Hedgepeth, Water Department Supervisor, presented a Water Shortage Response Plan and Resolution.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the Water Shortage Response Plan and Resolution. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION
FOR
APPROVING WATER SHORTAGE RESPONSE PLAN**

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 143-355 (1) requires that each unit of local government that provides public water services or plans to provide such services shall, either individually or together with other such units of local government, prepare and submit a Water Shortage Response Plan; and

WHEREAS, as required by the statutes and in the interests of sound local planning, a Water Shortage Response Plan for the Gates County Water Department has been developed and submitted to the Gates County Board of Commissioners for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Gates County Board of Commissioners finds that the Water Shortage Response plan is in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina General Statute 143-355(1) and that it will provide appropriate guidance for the future management of water supplies for the Gates County Water Department, as well as useful information to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources for the development of a state water supply plan as required by statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Gates County that the Water Shortage Response Plan entitled, Water Shortage Response Plan, Gates County, North Carolina, dated January 22, 2010, is hereby approved and shall be submitted to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Water Resources; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gates County Board of Commissioners intends that this plan shall be revised to reflect changes in relevant data and projections at least once every five years or as otherwise requested by the Department, in accordance with the statute and sound planning practice.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the 2011 Rural Operating Assistance Program Application. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew presented his concern to waive the permit fee for individual residential handicap ramps. This item will be tabled until the September 1 Commissioners' Meeting.

Citizen Comments

Dan Bazemore, Eure, wanted to recognize Commissioner Askew for his work on having the speed limit reduced on the White Oak Road.

Commissioner Comments

Commissioner Jordan stated he discussed with Mr. Crocker, Sunbury Ruritan Club, the Ruritan Streetlight Project. Commissioner Jordan would like to discuss with the Tax/Water Billing Office regarding assessing funds from the citizens in the Sunbury area to be used towards the streetlight utility expense.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter into Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(1)(4). Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to immediately release a Request for Qualifications for Engineering Services for Gates County Wastewater Treatment Facility and Sewer Collection System Improvements. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion for the County to move forward with the \$700,000 Rural Center Grant. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to authorize Cavanaugh and Associates to solicit the cost of repair to the existing wastewater treatment system. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.




