

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
DECEMBER 2, 2009**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, December 2, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Jordan, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Twine were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

Mr. Chappell called the meeting to order. The first order of the day was to elect a new Chairman.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to open the floor for nominations for Chairman. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew nominated Commissioner Twine for Chairman.

Commissioner Nickens nominated Commissioner Jordan for Chairman.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to close the floor for nominations. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell called for a vote in the order of nomination. Commissioners Jernigan, Askew and Twine voted for Commissioner Twine. Commissioners Jordan and Nickens were opposed. Commissioners Jordan and Nickens voted for Commissioner Jordan. Commissioners Jernigan, Askew and Twine were opposed. The new Chairman to the Board will be Commissioner Twine elected by a majority vote.

Mr. Chappell turned the meeting over to Chairman Twine.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to open the floor for nominations for Vice-Chairman. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens nominated Commissioner Jordan for Vice-Chairman.

Commissioner Askew nominated Commissioner Jernigan for Vice-Chairman.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to close the floor for nominations. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine called for a vote in the order of nomination. Commissioners Nickens and Jordan voted for Commissioner Jordan. Chairman Twine and Commissioners Jernigan and Askew were opposed. Chairman Twine and Commissioners Jernigan and Askew voted for Commissioner Jernigan. Commissioners Nickens and Jordan were opposed. The Vice-Chairman to the Board will be Commissioner Jernigan elected by a majority vote.

Commissioner Jernigan stated he would accept the position as Vice-Chairman to the Board.

Rev. Tracy Clayton conducted a prayer and Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

**Approval of Agenda**

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the Agenda as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to approve the Minutes of the November 4<sup>th</sup> and November 16<sup>th</sup> meetings as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

### **Department Reports**

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 33-36.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 33-36 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the Tax Collector's Report.

Reba Green-Holley, Cooperative Extension Director, recognized the Governor's Medallion Award recipient, Dillon Chappell and the Volunteer Award Recipient, Dr. Peggy Johnston.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, requested a refund of a variance fee for Moncure Homes on behalf of Lois Knight.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to refund the variance fee in full to Moncure Homes on behalf of Lois Knight. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

### **New Business**

Earl Rountree, requested the Commissioners budget next year to demolish the back portion of the Sunbury School; the portion has no significant historical value. He also requested to set a timeframe for taking action on the facility.

Commissioner Askew stated he had received citizen comments regarding employees parking in the front parking spaces at the courthouse. After discussing the issue, the Board requested all employees, unless there is a documented physical need by a physician, to park in the rear parking lot.

Paulette Wester requested more than one (1) handicapped parking space be provided.

Mr. Chappell will address the parking issue with employees and the handicapped parking issue will be discussed at the January meeting.

Reba Green-Holley requested handicapped parking be assessed at the Extension Office.

Commissioner Askew requested the condition of the signs in the County be assessed. Many signs have been damaged or destroyed throughout the County.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

### **Commissioner Comments**

Commissioner Jernigan stated the Albemarle Museum will be sponsoring "Gates County Day" on December 13, 2:00 pm – 5:00 pm.

Commissioner Jordan stated he had received a letter from the State Ethics Commission regarding the Evaluation of Statement of Economic Interest Filed by Mr. Benjamin Saunders as an appointee to the College of the Albemarle Board of Trustees ("Board"). At this time an actual conflict of interest could not be found; however, the potential for a conflict was found. The potential conflict identified does not prohibit service on this entity. Pursuant to NCGS 138A-15(c): When an actual or potential conflict of interest is cited by the commission under NCGS 138A-24(e) with regard to a public servant sitting on a board, the conflict shall be recorded in the minutes of the applicable board and duly brought to the attention of the membership by the board's chair as often as necessary to remind all members of the conflict and to help ensure compliance with the Chapter.

Commissioner Jordan stated a Town Hall Meeting has been scheduled for 6:00 p.m., January 11, 2010 at the Community Center. The purpose of the Town Hall Meeting is to discuss courses being offered at COA and ESCU for future positions in the aviation field with DRS Technologies located at the Coast Guard Base in Elizabeth City.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.




