

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
APRIL 3, 2013**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, April 3, 2013 in the main courtroom, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Jordan, Owens, Hora, Jernigan and Hofler were present. Also present was County Manager, Jon Mendenhall.

Chairman Jordan led a prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the Minutes of March 2, 5, 6, 7, 11 and 18 as presented. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Agenda

Commissioner Hofler made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Delegations – Unannounced

Thomas Hill, Sunbury, presented his application to serve on the Ad hoc Animal Welfare Advisory Committee.

Amanda Smith, Corapeake, stated there are still concerns of animal abuse existing in the county and she requests the Board make changes.

Carol Whit, Gates, stated the Sheriff needs a full-time Animal Control Officer and two (2) animal cruelty investigators. The investigators are of no cost to the County but would be volunteers appointed by the Commissioners. The Board needs to invest in the care of animals.

Chuck Brothers, Gates, discussed the proposed adult care facility at Merchants Commerce. The facility is not meeting their proposed timeline; land has not been purchased and he feels the liability is being placed on the County.

Wesley Boone, representing Gates Partners for Health, expressed the dire need for continued funding from the County.

Administrative Reports

Jon Mendenhall, County Manager, presented the March Administrative Report.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Administrator, presented the March Tax Collector's Report.

Public Hearings

Chairman Jordan presented a request by Graham Twine, to rezone three (3) parcels, 007, 019 and the un-numbered parcel in between the two lots on Catherine Creek Road, Hobbsville, from A-1 to RMH-1.

Commissioner Hofler made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the Graham Twine rezoning request. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

There being no public comment Commissioner Owens made a motion to exit the Public Hearing. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to follow the recommendation of the Planning Board to approve the three parcels for Graham Twine to be rezoned from A-1 to RMH-1. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Jordan presented a request by David Spruill to rezone three (3) parcels on Little Island Road, Eure, from R-1 to RMH-1.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the David Spruill rezoning request. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

There being no public comment Commissioner Owens made a motion to exit the Public Hearing. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to follow the recommendation of the Planning Board to approve the three parcels for David Spruill to be rezoned from R-1 to RMH-1. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

New Business

Chairman Jordan presented for consideration the organizational structure of an Ad-hoc Animal Welfare Advisory Committee.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept the organizational structure as modified and presented. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The organizational structure of an Ad-hoc Animal Welfare Advisory Committee reads as follows:

Gates County Government
Organization of an Ad-hoc Advisory Committee
for
Animal Welfare

WHEREAS, the condition of animals and their welfare is of particular concern to the citizens of Gates County; and
WHEREAS, the County is empowered by GS 153A-121 to define, regulate, prohibit, or abate acts, omissions, or conditions detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of its citizens and the peace and welfare of the county; and
WHEREAS, the Gates County Board of Commissioners deems that public input is necessary and fundamental in the process of good governance;
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an ad-hoc Animal Welfare Advisory Committee is created pursuant to the following:

NAME

Animal Welfare Advisory Committee, hereafter "Committee"

TENURE

To commence on the 1st day of May, 2013 and to expire on the 31st day of December, 2013.

SCOPE

To generally identify animal welfare needs and recommend courses of action to improve the condition of animal welfare generally, but also to specifically address:

Animal Adoption and Stewardship of Sheltered Animals
Animal Cruelty (including tethering)
Ordinance Consistency (strays and dealing with future ordinance language changes)

RULES OF PROCEDURE

Basic rules of procedure shall be promulgated by the Committee using Robert's Rules of order as a template.

MEMBERSHIP

The Committee shall be comprised of nine (9) members:

- 1 Appointed by the Eure District Commissioner
- 1 Appointed by the Hobbsville District Commissioner
- 1 Appointed by the Gates District Commissioner
- 1 Appointed by the Gatesville District Commissioner
- 1 Appointed by the Sunbury District Commissioner
- 1 Appointed by the Tri-County Animal Shelter
- 1 Appointed by the Health Department
- 1 Appointed by the Sheriff
- 1 Appointed by the County Manager

FUNDING

No funding has been authorized to reimburse, support, or otherwise provide for funds or funding for this Committee.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve Budget Amendment 44 as presented. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Citizens' Comments

Thomas Hill, Sunbury, stated he was concerned with the process of appointing members to the Animal Welfare Advisory Committee.

Geoffrey Marett, DSS Director, stated Chairman Jordan's term will end on the DSS Board on May 30; another Commissioner will need to be appointed to this position or Chairman Jordan can be reappointed.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter Closed Session authorized by NCGS §143-318.11(a)(3)(4)(5)(6). Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to authorize Commissioner Owens and the County's attorney to negotiate with the party as discussed in Closed Session. Chairman Jordan seconded the motion. Chairman Jordan and Commissioners Owens, Jernigan and Hofler voted for the motion. Commissioner Hora voted against the motion. Motion carried by a majority vote.

Commissioner Hora requested to be recused from voting on the next issue.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to approve Commissioner Hora's request to be recused. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to instruct the County Manager to discuss options with parties discussed in Closed Session. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan exits the meeting.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to enter Closed Session as authorized by NCGS §143-318.11(a)(3)(4)(6). Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.




