

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
MAY 4, 2011**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, May 4, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Hora, Owens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Rev. Wesley Boone. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Twine stated the Agenda needs to be amended by the following: Madison Tatum will be moved to the beginning of the meeting, a Planning Board member re-appointment will be discussed, Reba Greene-Holley will discuss a memorandum of agreement and there will be a Closed Session authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6).

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept the Agenda as amended. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Minutes of April 2 and 6 with corrections. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition

Chairman Twine read a Proclamation proclaiming May as Asthma Awareness Month and presented it to Madison Tatum, a fourth grade student at T. S. Cooper School.

Citizen Comments

J. E. Harrell, Gates, stated he supported saving the old courthouse and gifting it to the Gates County Historical Society.

Cal Bryant, Roanoke-Chowan News Herald Editor, presented the latest edition of Front Porch living.

Department Reports

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendment 57.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve Budget Amendment 57 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Pittman stated after interviewing brokers the Pierce Group presented a health benefits plan to best serve the County.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Pierce Group as the provider of health benefits for the County. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the April Tax Collector's Report. Gwen Harrell, Deputy Tax Collector, presented a request for tax refunds for Glendon Goodman, \$159.42 and Marion Knight, \$247.33.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the Request for Tax Refunds as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, Billy Winn, Emergency Management Director and Edgar Mitchell, Building Inspection Director, presented text for a Proposed Condemned Dwelling Ordinance. A final draft and Public Hearing will be held at a later date.

Ms. Jethro presented the Final Plat Approval for Merchants Commerce Center.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to open the Public Hearing on the Merchants Commerce Center Final Plat Approval. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Thomas Langston, Gates, asked who the other developers are at this time and stated the development needed to be reviewed carefully.

Kim Old, owner, stated he was unable to answer at this time.

J. E. Harrell, Gates, stated he would like to see a fast food site developed in the area and also industrial development.

Dan Bazemore, Eure, stated he would like the Commissioners to be responsible for businesses coming into the Commerce Center. Would like the Board to consider requesting Mr. Old have a \$20 million bond with time constraints.

Jonathan Jones, Vice-President, State Employees Credit Union, thanked the Board in advance for their vote and for looking forward to the betterment of the County. He stated Mr. Old is here to bring jobs to the County.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the Final Plat Approval as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine, stated since the Merchants Commerce Center Final Plat was approved, Micky Lee, Lee Insurance, requested the Chairman announce Lee Insurance will be moving to the Merchants Commerce Center.

Ms. Jethro stated Joe Greene has requested to be re-appointed to the Planning Board. He is currently serving as vice-chairman.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to re-appoint Joe Greene to the Planning Board for another three (3) year term. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Attorney Pitt Godwin leaves the meeting.

Reba Green-Holley, Extension Director, and Jay Tomlinson, NCSU Director of Design Community Design Initiative and the Downtown Design Studio, presented the preliminary Growing Gates Focus Group Report.

Mrs. Holley presented a Memorandum of Agreement for Extension Reserve Funds.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Memorandum of Agreement as presented. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

New Business

Dr. Zenobia Smallwood, Superintendent, presented the 2011-2012 Budget for Gates County Schools.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

Commissioner Jordan presented a request from the Housing committee to provide funding for a housing coordinator position. The current coordinator's position is through a partnership with AmeriCorp VISTA. This partnership will end May 13, 2011. He is requesting to fund this position from May 13, 2011 to June 30, 2011 at a cost of \$1,500.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to authorize the County Manager to locate funds to extend the position and authorize the housing committee to explore options to support

this position. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion. Commissioners Jernigan, Hora, Owens and Jordan voted for the motion. Chairman Twine voted against the motion due to the existing Resolution stating no County funds would be used for the Housing Committee Budget. Motion carried by a majority vote.

Commissioner Comments

Chairman Twine responded to a previous topic of no passing zones at convenience sites. The Department of Transportation has performed a traffic study at the Roduco convenience site. There will be no change in the passing zone. There will be no change in the location of the speed limit sign in Eure.

Chairman Twine discussed the possibility of setting up a Board of Zoning Review to discuss with citizens on an individual basis property zoning concerns.

Mrs. McGinnis was called back to discuss a Request for Tax Refund to Malinda Cross heirs, Mary Riddick and Sharon Scott, \$340.49

Chairman Twine made a motion to approve the refund as requested. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion. Chairman Twine, Commissioners Jernigan and Hora voted for the motion. Commissioners Owens and Jordan voted against the motion. Motion passed by a majority vote.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter Closed Session authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6). Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the contract for the County Manager for two (2) years as discussed. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion. Chairman Twine and Commissioners Jernigan, Owens and Jordan voted for the motion. Commissioner Hora abstained. Motion carried.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to recess until May 16, 2011. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
