

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 5, 2011**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, October 5, 2011 in the main courtroom, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Hora, Owens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Commissioner Jordan. Commissioner Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Twine stated the Agenda needed to be amended by the following: Reba Green-Holley will present a Budget Amendment, Toby Chappell will present for Billy Winn and the East Carolina Behavior Health presentation will be after the Citizens' Comments.

Commissioner Hora requested a second Citizens' Comments item be added to the Agenda. The policy will be addressed.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the amended Agenda. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the September 7 and 19 Meeting Minutes as amended. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Special Recognition

Chairman Twine presented certificates of appreciation for outstanding performance and contribution to the County during Hurricane Irene to various departments.

Citizen's Comments

Joe Greene, Eure, read a letter written by his wife, a previous library employee, detailing services provided by the local library that are not recorded.

Wade Askew, Eure, gave updated statistics on Bertie, Hertford and Northampton County libraries.

Tiffany Clements, Gates, stated the County needed to do something else with its money than build a new library; the county needed to do something to bring in money.

New Business

Roy Wilson, CEO, and Joy Futrell, Finance Officer, East Carolina Behavioral Health, presented the ECBH Semi-Annual Report.

Department Reports

Reba Green-Holley, Extension Director, presented Budget Amendments 12 and 13.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 12 – 13 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented a Surplus and Disposition of Assets for Emergency Management. Mr. Winn is requesting to sell some donated equipment and materials and the proceeds go to the Emergency Management Department.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the request as presented. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Old Business

Mr. Chappell stated Water Department billing cycles are still being discussed. Plans should be presented at the next meeting.

Mr. Chappell presented the LS3P Associates revised contract. The design fee has been reduced and text concerns have been addressed.

After discussion by the Board, Commissioner Hora made a motion to postpone the LS3P contract until information presented by Commissioner Jordan can be reviewed. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion. Commissioners Hora and Jordan voted for the motion. Chairman Twine and Commissioners Jernigan and Owens voted against the motion. Motion did not pass by a majority vote.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the LS3P contract as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion. Chairman Twine and Commissioners Jernigan and Owens voted for the motion. Commissioners Hora and Jordan voted against the motion. Motion carried by a majority vote.

New Business

Chairman Twine presented a request to reappoint Abrom Saunders, James Sears and John Taylor Kittrell to the Gates County Human Relations Commission each for a three year term, October 1, 2011 to September 30, 2014.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to appoint Mr. Saunders, Mr. Sears and Mr. Kittrell each to another three year term to the Gates County Human Relations Commission. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine presented a request to appoint Sandra Nickens and Anne Howell to the Gates County Community Advisory Committee each for a one each term, October 1, 2011 to September 30, 2012. Commissioner Jordan made a motion to appoint Mrs. Nickens and Mrs. Howell to the Gates County Community Advisory Committee. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine discussed the request for qualifications received for the possible stabilization/renovation of the old courthouse. It was the consensus of the Board to interview seven companies. These companies are: WBA, Ware Bonsall Architects, Charlotte; McPherson Design Group, P.C., Structural Engineers, Norfolk; MHA Works, P.A., Greenville; Clearscapes, Raleigh; OCA, Oakley Collier Architects, Rocky Mount; HagerSmith Design, P.A., Raleigh and Darden J. Eure and Associates, P.A., New Bern.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept the seven named firms to interview. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Citizens' Comments

Anthony Felton, Eure, questioned if fundraisers could be held for the new library instead of using tax payers' money.

Robert Winslow, Sunbury, stated he does not think it is a good idea to renovate the old courthouse and put the library back in it. The County could make money off of the courthouse as an historic site.

Ashley Taylor, Gates, stated he has noticed in his travels that libraries are an outstanding addition to communities. Libraries are a center point, a significant point of a community. His suggestion is to continue to move forward for tomorrow for the County to grow.

Commissioners' Comments

Commissioner Jordan stated he is glad to get the grant for the Housing Committee; he asks the Board to extend the Housing Coordinator's contract.

Commissioner Hora stated citizens need to get involved and make a personal commitment to use the library.

Commissioner Jernigan stated moving forward with the library and courthouse is the way to go.

Chairman Twine asked the citizens to challenge the Board to make sure the County gets the best for their money. He will be watching the new library process closely as an electrical and mechanical contractor and as a citizen.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to extend the Housing Coordinator's contract out of fund balance or other available source until the Capacity Funding Grant is received. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to enter Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6). Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commission Owens made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.




