

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
JUNE 2, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, June 2, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Commissioner Jordan. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Agenda**

Chairman Twine stated the following items needed to be added to the Agenda: Department Reports B.3. CDBG Forms and B.4 Reappointments to the Board of Adjustments, Item C. Toby Chappell.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Agenda with amendments. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the May 5 and May 17 Meeting Minutes as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Department Reports**

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the April 2010 Tax Collector's Report. Mrs. McGinnis stated the software used by the Tax Department can process bank drafts for water payments; Southern Bank will be able to process the drafts without a charge to the County. She will continue working to complete the process.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented a proposal by the Planning Board to conduct a housing fair to educate the citizens of Gates County on their housing options.

Commissioner Askew made a motion for the Planning Board to proceed with plans for a housing fair. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Ms. Jethro stated the Planning Board requested she draft a letter to Representative Mobley and Senator Jones expressing concern over the exempt status of parcels of land greater than ten (10) acres, per NCGS 153A-335(2) and how this statute applies to our County's subdivision ordinance. The state law has been in force for over fifty (50) years.

Commissioner Jordan stated he would like dimensions placed on the size of the lots, particularly pertaining to road frontage.

Attorney Godwin and Ms. Jethro stated they would research this issue and report back to the Board.

Ms. Jethro presented the Scattered Site CDBG Program Citizen Participation Plan, Citizens Complaint Procedure Form and Residential Anti-Displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adopt the Citizen Participation Plan, Citizens Complaint Procedure Form and Residential Anti-Displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan for the CDBG Program. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Ms. Jethro presented Board of Adjustments members whose terms expire June 30, 2010: Graham Hawkins would like to continue to serve but as an alternate, William Harrell would like to continue to serve as an alternate, Mickey Lee would not like to serve another term.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to open the floor for nominations to fill the two vacant Board of Adjustments positions. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine nominated Terry Eure to fill the seat held by Mickey Lee.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to close the nominations. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Twine asked for a vote for Terry Eure. There was a unanimous vote for Mr. Eure. He will serve a three year term, July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to open the floor for nominations for the Board of Adjustments positions. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew nominated William Harrell as an alternate Board of Adjustments member and Graham Hawkins to continue as an alternate Board of Adjustments member.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to close the nominations. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Twine asked for a vote for William Harrell and Graham Hawkins as alternate Planning Board members. It was a unanimous vote from the Board. Mr. Harrell and Mr. Hawkins will each serve a three year term, July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013.

Toby Chappell, County Manager, presented Budget Amendments 68-83. He stated Budget Amendment 68 will be held at this time.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept Budget Amendments 69-83 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell discussed the proposal of the County assuming the responsibility of the Community Center Nutrition Site employee. This employee is currently an employee of the Albemarle Commission.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to request the Albemarle Commission to bring another contract to the Commissioners for consideration. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan discussed a Proposed Ordinance to Regulate Loud, Disturbing Noise in Gates County. He is waiting on representatives from Duke University to make final corrections and will present the ordinance at the July 7 Commissioners' Meeting.

### **New Business**

Bert Banks, Albemarle Commission Director, discussed services provided to Gates County by the Albemarle Commission. He thanked the Commissioners for allowing the Albemarle Commission to provide services to the citizens.

Sterling Baker, Gretchen Byrum, Ronnie Sawyer and Jerry Jennings, NC Department of Transportation, were finalizing the 2009-2010 Secondary Roads Construction Program and presented the 2010-2011 Program.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to accept the 2010-2011 Secondary Roads Construction Program as presented. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

After a brief recess Chairman Twine called the meeting back to order.

Adrienne Bradley, JCPC Chairperson, Gates County Board of Education, requested approval of JCPC Board members.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the members of the JCPC Board as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Ricky Winebarger, Gates County 4-H Agent and Lulu Eure, Community Center Director, presented a request to construct a dirt bicycle track at the Community Center, The 4-H program would like to start a bicycle club and use the track. Brian White, Cycle Speedway, Edenton, stated he would provide safety instruction.

The Board requested to research the liability insurance aspect and report back to the Board at the July 7 meeting.

Mr. John Crocker, Sunbury Ruritan Club, discussed the Sunbury Streetlight Project. The Ruritan Club pays the utility cost for the 28 streetlights; they have enough funds to pay invoices through the summer. Once a streetlight is turned off there will be a \$100 re-activation fee. They are asking the Board for financial assistance to maintain the streetlights. Mr. Crocker has submitted a grant to Dominion Power for financial assistance but has not had a response yet. Mr. Chappell stated he would send a letter to Dominion Power regarding the status of the grant.

Mr. T. C. Vaughan, Eure Volunteer Fire Department Treasurer, presented a Resolution to the Board requesting approval of a tax-exempt loan to purchase a new fire truck.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the Resolution approving a tax-exempt loan for the Eure Volunteer Fire Department to purchase a new fire truck. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented a lease agreement between LFM Properties, LLC and Camden, Gates, Pasquotank and Perquimans Counties for the Child Support Office.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to accept the lease agreement between LFM Properties, LLC and Camden, Gates, Pasquotank and Perquimans Counties for the Child Support Office. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented the proposed changes to the Personnel Policy by the Personnel Board.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adopt the proposed changes to the Personnel Policy. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew discussed nominating a representative as the Commercial Fishing Representative to the NC Coastal Resources Commission.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to open the floor for nominations for the Commercial Fishing Representative to the NC Coastal Resources Commission. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew nominated Lee Wynns as the Commercial Fishing Representative.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion the nominations be closed. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

After a unanimous vote from the Board, Lee Wynns was nominated as the Commercial Fishing Representative to the NC Coastal Resources Commission.

Chairman Twine questioned the Board regarding the Citizen’s Comment section of the Agenda.

Commissioner Jordan stated the Chairman holds authority of the meeting.

Commissioner Jernigan stated there is a standing three (3) minute time limit and the Chairman has the authority to extend the time if the subject is worthy.

Commissioner Nickens stated the Chairman has the authority and conducts the meeting.

Commissioner Askew stated the Chairman conducts the meeting.

Chairman Twine stated once a citizen signs up to speak there will be a three (3) minute time limit; he will have the discretion to extend the time if worthy; there will be no hand-off of time to another person.

### Citizen Comments

Penny Heishman, Gatesville, voiced her concern with the proposed new library. She stated research needs to be conducted on the use and feasibility of a new library.

Dan Bazemore, Eure, presented the following questions: What is the status of no passing lines on the highway at the convenience sites? What is the status of the Chowan Swamp Road closures? What is the status to the process of notifying property owners of dilapidated or burned homes? What is the planned use of the medical center?

Ann Askew, Eure, commented positively on the CERT Training conducted by Billy Winn, EMS Director.

John Hora, Eure, presented a projected cost analysis of a new library.

Thomas Langston, Gates, stated he thought the Commissioners' Room needed to be expanded.

Milton Carter, a citizen, stated the computers at the library had a filter that prevented the use of social interneting; he felt this was a violation of the law.

Mr. Chappell responded to Mr. Bazemore's questions: Gretchen Byrum with the NC Dept. of Transportation has already received a letter requesting no-passing areas be located in front of the convenience sites. A meeting has been held with the NC Wildlife Commission and a schedule for controlled access to the Chowan Swamp roads will be put into affect. The Emergency Management Director, Building Inspector and Planning Director are working on a policy regarding dilapidated and burned homes; money has been put into the 2010-2011 budget to implement this policy. The County's attorney and Rural Health Center's attorney are finalizing the deed for the transfer of the property; Mr. Chappell stated he had recently met with a dentist who wanted to open the facility.

Mr. Bazemore stated he would like it stated in Board Meetings the projects that are being worked on.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter into Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6).

Commissioner Askew made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to recess until 10:00 a.m. on June 11. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
