

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 3, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, November 3, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Rev. Roger Kiker. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Agenda**

Chairman Twine stated the Agenda needed to be amended: Mr. Winn will be first under Department Reports, Sunbury School will be added to Old Business, the Chairman will have an item of New Business and Closed Session will be authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(a)(3)(4)(6).

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Agenda as amended. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 6, 2010 Commissioners' Meeting as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Department Reports**

Billy Winn, Emergency Management Director, discussed the Viper Radio System. He is trying to develop a 10-year radio plan for the County with the use of this system with funds that will only be available for the next two (2) years.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the October Tax Collector's Report and discussed the foreclosure process for the purpose of collecting delinquent taxes. The attorney will review the process and return to the next meeting with changes.

Reba Green-Holley, Cooperative Extension Director, presented Budget Amendments 26-29.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 26-29. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Patrice Lassiter, GITS Director, presented the GITS Safety Program.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the GITS Safety Program. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented a text change to Section 7.02 Notes to the Table of Permitted Uses, adding f. Bakeries, to the list of permitted home occupations.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to open the Public Hearing to the text change to Section 7.02. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, stated a list of businesses was not necessary as long as businesses fit a certain criteria.

Jon Rissmiller, Eure, questioned what happens to existing businesses that do not fit the criteria.

Ms. Jethro will review his concern.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to close the Public Hearing for the text change to Section 7.02. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to allow the addition of Bakery to the current ordinance and request the Planning Board put together a generic language to cover this concern in the future. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented text for the Boards consideration in rewriting Section 7.02 of the Gates County Zoning Ordinance.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to forward the proposed text submitted by Mr. Chappell to the Planning Board for a 30-day review. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

### **Old Business**

Mr. Chappell discussed funding for a Civil War Marker in Gatesville. The Chamber of Commerce will match funding by the Historical Society up to \$250. The Town of Gatesville has not met to discuss the subject.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to fund the difference in the cost of the Civil War Marker. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented a request for Permission for Temporary Easement/Entry Agreement from the NC Division of Tourism, Film and Sports Development for the installation of a Civil War Marker.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to sign the request for Permission for Temporary Easement/Entry Agreement. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell discussed Preservation North Carolina marketing Sunbury School.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to set a purchase price for Sunbury School starting at \$75,000 with a covenant and giving the Chairman, County Manager and Attorney authority to sign documents necessary to proceed with the marketing process. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Carolyn Morris, CDBG Grant Administrator, Albemarle Commission, discussed the specifications for the construction of two one-story dwellings as part of the amended 2008 Scattered Site Housing Project.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Godfrey Brothers as the contractor to construct the two (2) dwellings as part of the amended 2008 Scattered Site Housing Project. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Morris questioned if the contractor could build both houses simultaneously. The only change in the contractor's price would be the price of the performance bond.

Mrs. Morris presented a Budget Amendment to reallocate funds within the current C-1 Budget to allow funding to complete the project and add an additional housing unit to the project.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the Budget Amendment to reallocate funds within the current C-1 Budget to allow funding to complete the project and add an additional housing unit. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to resend the previous motion approving Godfrey Brothers to build two (2) dwellings for the amended 2008 Scattered Site Housing Project. The performance bond cost had not been included in the bids received from the

contractors when it clearly stated in the bid request a performance bond would be required to be awarded a contract. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Morris will be in attendance at the next Commissioners' Meeting with information from all bidders regarding performance bond prices.

Mr. Chappell presented the application for North Carolina State Lottery Funds that has already been approved by the Gates County Board of Education.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to sign the application for North Carolina State Lottery Funds. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented a request to review the County's membership in NC-20. It was the consensus of the Board for a representative from NC-20 be in attendance at the next Commissioners' Meeting to discuss the benefits to the County.

Mr. Chappell presented a request from Cumberland County to choose a County veteran representative for the North Carolina Veterans Park in Fayetteville.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to nominate Cecil Taylor, a Pearl Harbor survivor, as the veteran representative from the County. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew presented a request by New Hanover County to support their Resolution to request House Speaker Joe Hackney to reverse the ban on sectarian prayers in the North Carolina House of Representatives.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to send a Resolution in support of New Hanover County's request to reverse the ban on sectarian prayers in the North Carolina House of Representatives. Commissioners Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolutions reads as follows:

#### **RESOLUTION**

#### **REQUESTING HOUSE SPEAKER JOE HACKNEY TO REVERSE BAN ON SECTARIAN PRAYERS**

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina State House Speaker Joe Hackney banned the use of sectarian prayers by volunteer ministers during the opening prayers for the North Carolina House of Representatives; and

**WHEREAS**, a volunteer minister presenting the opening prayer in the 2010 North Carolina House of Representatives was relieved of his duties due to praying "In Jesus Name;" and

**WHEREAS**, ministers speaking before the North Carolina House of Representatives should be allowed to offer sectarian prayers according to his/her conscience.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Gates County Board of Commissioners calls on House Speaker Joe Hackney to reverse the ban on sectarian prayers in North Carolina House of Representatives.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Gates County Board of County Commissioners urges all other counties in North Carolina to join in this request to Speaker Hackney.
