

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 4, 2009**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, November 4, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Jordan, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Twine were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order. A prayer was led by Rev. Gene Asbill. Chairman Jordan led the pledge of allegiance.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Jordan stated George Eure will be taking Eric Earhart's place on the agenda and the matters to be discussed by Mr. Eure and Mr. Old and Dr. Fisher will be moved to Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(a)(4).

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to accept the agenda as presented with modifications. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Twine made a motion to approve the Minutes of the October 7, October 20, October 26 and October 29 meetings as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Department Reports

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 29-32.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 29-32 as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the Tax Collector's Report.

Chairman Jordan read the charge to empower the Tax Assessor to collect the 2009 taxes.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to approve the charge to empower the Tax Assessor to collect the 2009 taxes. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The charge reads as follows:

To the Tax Collector of the County of Gates

State of North Carolina

County of Gates

You are hereby authorized, empowered, and commanded to collect the taxes set forth in the tax records filed in the office of the Tax Assessor and/or Collector and in the tax receipts herewith delivered to you, in the amounts and from the taxpayers likewise therein set forth. Such taxes are hereby declared to be the first lien upon all real property of the respective taxpayers in the County of Gates, and this order shall be a full and sufficient authority to direct, require and enable you to levy on and sell any real or personal property of such taxpayers, for and on account thereof, in accordance with law, NCGS 105-321(b).

Old Business

The Resolution reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION
TO INCREASE THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES BOARD
TO FIVE MEMBERS**

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Gates County Board of Commissioners, through our annual audit report, that there is a lack of local authority given to County Management to ensure the Department of Social Services complies with county directives, general statutes, and Social Security Administration administrative rules; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 108A-5 allows the Board of Commissioners to expand a three member board to a five member board of social services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners considers a five member board to be more effective in ensuring the operation and management of the Gates County Department of Social Services;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT WE, the Board of Commissioners of Gates County, on this the 4th day of November, 2009, do hereby increase the Gates County Department of Social Services Board to five members.

Commissioner Twine nominated John Hora as the Commissioner appointee to the DSS Board. Chairman Jordan asked for any other nominations. Commissioner Nickens nominated Chairman Jordan to serve on the DSS Board as Commissioner representative at the expiration of Mr. William Harrell's term in June 2010.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to close the nominations. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to appoint John Hora as the Commissioner appointee to the DSS Board to become effective immediately upon the appointment of a board member by the Department of Health and Human Services, and to appoint Chairman Jordan as the Commission representative to fill the seat of Mr. William Harrell at the expiration of his term in June 2010. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Anne Holley, DSS Child Protective Services, Dominique Williams and Sherry Boone, social workers, presented a Proclamation declaring November as Adoption Awareness Month.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to adopt the Proclamation declaring November as Adoption Awareness Month. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Proclamation reads as follows:

ADOPTION AWARENESS MONTH Proclamation

WHEREAS, the first major effort to promote awareness of the need for adoptive families for children in the foster care system occurred in 1976, when Massachusetts Governor Michael Dukakis issued the first state Adoption Week proclamation. President Gerald Ford made the first National Adoption Week proclamation, and in 1990, the week was expanded to a month due to the number of states participating and the number of events; and

WHEREAS, in North Carolina, over 3,000 children are awaiting adoption and another 10,000 children are living in foster care. Many of them have spent most of their lives in this temporary situation, and have moved within the child welfare system several times; and

WHEREAS, in 1992, Dave Thomas, founder of Wendy's – the famous fast food restaurant chain – established the Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption. He joined his family through adoption when he was six years old; and

WHEREAS, the vision for the Foundation is that every child deserves a permanent home and a loving family. The Foundation increases adoption awareness while supporting model adoption services programs; and

WHEREAS, area Departments of Social Services and private child placing agencies such as Children's Home Society work together to train, license and prepare prospective foster and adoptive parents to provide that permanent home and loving family; and

WHEREAS, the Gates County Department of Social Services has licensed foster and adoptive homes in our community and has supported placements and facilitated adoptions; and

WHEREAS, those foster and adoptive parents deserve praise and recognition for their compassion and dedication to these very special children;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Gates County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim November as Adoption Awareness Month and calls upon all citizens, community agencies and faith groups to offer praise and thanks to those who have fostered and adopted those children in need and encourage interested individuals and families to consider becoming a foster or adoptive home.

Chairman Jordan discussed the possibility of the County being the administrator of a \$690,000 Rural Center Grant to develop a sewer system to tie into the County's existing system.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to pursue the Rural Center Grant to develop a sewer system. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter into Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143.318.11(a)(6). Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to recess until 7:00 pm., November 16, 2009. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.


