

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 1, 2010**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Wednesday, September 1, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Commissioner Jordan. Chairman Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Twine stated the Agenda needed to be amended. The Closed Session will no longer be for economic development but personnel, the general statute needs to be changed from 143-318.11(a)(4) to 114-318.11(a)(6).

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the Agenda as amended. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 4, 17, 25 and 26 Commissioners' Meetings as presented. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Department Reports

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 12 – 16. Commissioner Askew questioned the timeliness of some of the invoices being presented. Mr. Chappell will draft a policy regarding the timeliness of invoices and payments and report back to the Board.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 12-16 as presented barring the County is in compliance with all general statutes pertaining to the timeliness of invoices. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Pittman stated correspondence had been received regarding lottery funds, hopefully this will compensate for the unexpected shortfall.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor, presented the August Tax Collector's Report. She also presented a request for a tax refund to Connie Saunders for \$269.54.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to approve the tax refund to Connie Saunders for \$269.54. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan requested to be recused.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve Commissioner Jernigan's request to be recused. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented a Final Plat approval request for Rose and Bruce Lee.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to approve the Final Plat for Rose and Bruce Lee. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to bring Commissioner Jernigan back to the meeting. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Toby Chappell presented the Medical Transportation Service Permitting Ordinance.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the Medical Transportation Service Permitting Ordinance. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

There being no public comment, Commissioner Nickens made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the Medical Transportation Service Permitting Ordinance. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to appoint Chairman Twine as the Commissioner appointee to the Medical Transportation Board for a three-year term. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Clerk to the Board will advertise for a citizen volunteer to be appointed to the Medical Transportation Board.

Old Business

Commissioner Jordan discussed the proposed new Noise Ordinance and his concern to move forward with the issue.

Commissioner Askew stated his concern to waive the permit fee for individual handicap ramps.

Commissioner Askew made a motion to waive the permit fee for individual handicap ramps. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Askew presented a policy to waive permit fees for 60 days as a result of a state or federally declared disaster. This subject will be discussed with the Building Inspector and discussed at the next meeting.

New Business

Mr. Chappell presented the Proposed 2011 Holiday Schedule.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the 2011 Holiday Schedule as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented the proposed changes to the Personnel Policy as recommended by the Personnel Committee.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adopt the changes to the Personnel Ordinance as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Citizen Comments

Joe Greene, Eure, stated the speed limit has been changed from 35 mph to 55 mph in Eure near Harrell Lane; he would like to see a school bus stop ahead sign placed in the area.

John Hora, Eure, stated he felt the proposed public library was a luxury item. He request the tax payers vote on this issue.

Kristen Kaul, Northeastern Counseling Services, wanted to update the Board on the out-patient services provided: grief counseling, psychological testing, works with the Gates County Medical Center, Coastal Pediatrics and the Gates County Department of Social Services.

Commissioner Comments

Chairman Twine stated county-wide storm updates would be provided on the Delta phone system, community bulletin boards and the County's web site. He stated notification has been received from the Rural Center the County's grant has been increased from \$355,000 to \$700,000 for the use for the wastewater project.

Pitt Godwin discussed the subject of the proposed new library being placed on a voter referendum. He stated there is no general statute authorizing a referendum to vote on a library. The authority lies with the governing board; there is no way statutorily this can be placed on a referendum.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to enter into Closed Session as authorized by NCGS 143.318.11(a)(6). Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to recess until 3:00 p.m. on September 20, 2010. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.




