

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 2, 2013**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, January 2, 2013 in the main courtroom, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Jordan, Owens, Hora, Jernigan and Hofler were present. Also present was Interim County Manager, Ken Windley.

Chairman Jordan led a prayer and pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Jordan stated the Agenda needed to be amended by the following: Item IV.B. will be presented by the Chairman.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the Agenda as amended. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the December 3, 5, 6 and 10 Minutes as amended. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Citizens' Comments

Frances Jenkins, President, NexxII Nun Ryders MC, a non-profit organization located at 790 US Hwy 13 North, Gates, stated they have spent \$10,000 to date on renovations to the old Doris and Rogers Restaurant. The property is currently zoned as A-1, not C-1. She has been instructed to apply for a Special Use Permit. Since the zoning is incorrect, she is requesting the Special Use Permit Fee be waived for the non-profit organization.

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, thanked the Commissioners for their kindness and consideration during the F. J. Outland/USS Independence recognition ceremony. The extra donations he has received will be donated to the Wounded Warrior Project.

Department Reports

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 28-30.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 28-30 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Administrator, presented the December Tax Collector's Report.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented a request by the Planning Board to reduce the two (2) foot freeboard requirement from two (2) feet to one (1) foot and FEMA would like the opportunity review the text change.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to open the Public Hearing on the Flood Plain Text Amendment. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chuck Brothers, Planning Board member, stated in regards to the Eure Christian Church request, the Planning Board voted on the one (1) foot freeboard reduction and he would like a copy of the ordinance stating the two (2) foot freeboard requirement.

Perry Eure, Eure, stated he has been working on the Eure Baptist Church Social Hall since March and would like the Board to vote on the freeboard issue today.

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, stated he would like the Board to vote on this issue today.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to exit the Public Hearing and continue the discussion at the January 23 meeting. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Old Business

Chairman Jordan responded to Chuck Brother's request regarding the retention pond expansion at Merchants Commerce Center. The architect for the new library had not made any provisions for the EPA required retention pond. The then County Manager, Mr. Chappell, authorized the funding of the retention pond expansion by the developer at the time of the retention pond construction to satisfy the requirement for the library.

Commissioner Hora stated he had not received a copy of the change order and did not feel it was the County's responsibility to cover the cost of the developer's responsibility.

Ken Windley, Interim County Manager, stated the retention pond is located at the best site. If the County located the retention pond on the library property the County would be responsible for maintaining the pond and it would also be a liability.

Chairman Jordan requested Mr. Windley consult the County's attorney regarding the architect's liability.

Mr. Brothers voiced a concern with the approval of the original plans with Phase I, Phase II and Phase III.

Chairman Jordan discussed the reallocation of funding for salaries in the Sheriff's Department. He stated the Personnel Board approved the request pending written documentation by the Sheriff.

Commissioner Hora made a recommendation the written recommendation provided by Sheriff Webb requesting additional funding for Deputy Jordan be approved and he be promoted to Senior Patrol Officer. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

New Business

Chairman Jordan announced the next County Manager will be Jon Mendenhall effective January 14, 2013.

Commissioner Hora stated his first choice was a County resident who displayed the qualities requested in the announcement but he would support the Boards decision.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the announcement of Jon Mendenhall as the next County Manager of Gates County as of January 14, 2013. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Jordan discussed appointing a Voting Delegate for the upcoming Legislative Goals Conference.

Commissioner Hora made a motion Jon Mendenhall attend the Legislative Goals Conference and be the Voting Delegate. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition. If Mr. Mendenhall is unable to attend Commissioner Owens will take his place.

Chairman Jordan stated at this time he would like to add to the Agenda the resignation of the Interim County Manager.

Commissioner Jernigan made the motion to add the resignation of the Interim County Manager, Ken Windley, to the Agenda effective January 18, 2013. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Windley thanked the Board for inviting him to the County and thanked the staff for their open reception.

Chairman Jordan discussed the update of the appointment of the Rural Planning Organization to the Transportation Advisory Committee and Technical Coordinating Committee. Morgan Jethro is currently representing the County and a second representative is needed.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to reappoint Commissioner Owens to the Transportation Advisory Committee and Technical Coordinating Committee. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Citizens' Comments

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, stated Art Pope, the Budget Advisor to the Governor is a conservative and the Board should not expect excessive funding from the State.

Commissioners' Comments

Chairman Jordan presented a recognition plaque to Commissioner Hofler for her five (5) years of distinguished service to the Planning Board.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter Closed Session as authorized by NCGS §143-318.11.(a)(4)(6). Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hofler made a motion to recess until January 23, 2013. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
