

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 7, 2012**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, March 7, 2012 in the main courtroom, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Jordan, Hora and Owens were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Commissioner Jordan. Commissioner Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Twine stated the Agenda needed to be amended by the following: Representative Mobley will be moved immediately following the first Citizens' Comments, the two ordinances presented by Ms. Jethro will also have public hearings and The Wooten Company will be having the first public hearing for the CDBG-Scattered Site Grant.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the amended Agenda. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the January 1 and 15 Meeting Minutes as amended. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Representative Annie Mobley asked for continued support as she runs again for Representative for District 5.

Citizen's Comments

Esther Lassiter, Gates Partners for Health, presented the State of the County Health Report for Gates County.

Department Reports

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 45-47.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to accept Budget Amendments 45-47 as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Pittman discussed a wellness program being conducted by the County's health care provider to help reduce health care cost. She would like the Board to make this mandatory participation for employees.

The Board requested the County Manager survey department heads to make sure fifty percent of the staff will participate. A final decision will be made at the next meeting.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Administrator, presented the February Tax Collector's Report and Requests for Tax Refunds to Karen E. Nowell, \$147.75, Brenda Bagley, \$211.57 and Debra H. Earley, \$437.00.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to refund the taxes as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. McGinnis presented three (3) bids received for foreclosed property located on the Tuggie Eure Road.

Commissioner Hora requested to be recused.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to recuse Commissioner Hora from voting on this issue. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the \$8,000 bid on the Tuggie Eure Road property. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. McGinnis presented bids on foreclosed property located on 158 West, Roduco.

Commissioner Hora requested to be recused.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to recuse Commissioner Hora from voting on this issue. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept the bid of \$4,110 for the foreclosed property located at 158 West, Roduco. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. McGinnis suggested opening the Board of Equalization and Review on April 30 and closing on May 21.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the schedule for the Board of Equalization and Review as stated by Mrs. McGinnis. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. McGinnis discussed Zacchaeus Legal Services, a tax foreclosure firm. The Board will make a decision at the March 19 meeting.

Mrs. McGinnis presented a Request for Surplus and Disposition of Assets of miscellaneous office equipment to be sold on GovDeals. If the items are not sold on GovDeals they are to be disposed of through PCG electronic recycling.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the Request for Surplus and Disposition of Assets as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Lulu Eure, Community Center Director, discussed a new law that came into effect December 2011 enabling concealed weapons to be carried at parks and recreation facilities. There is an amendment in the law that County governments can prohibit such. Due to the close proximity of the properties she would like to have a policy to cover the Community Center. The schools already have a policy in place. Mr. Chappell suggests the School Board amend their policy to include the Gates County Community Center and its entirety.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to adopt the language presented by the County Manager and accept the Board of Education's amended policy; the County will provide the plaques. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Colleen Turner, DSS Director, gave an update on the DSS Director's recruitment process; 11 applications were received with an anticipated start date of April 16. She also gave an update on the Gates County Housing Committee. The Housing Coordinator will be assessing every home in the County.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

Billy Winn, Emergency Management Director, presented the Hazardous Materials Emergency Planning Grant and the Albemarle Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to accept both the grant and the plan and any attachments as necessary. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented the Proposed Landscaping Ordinance.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to open the Public Hearing for the Proposed Landscaping Ordinance. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to close the Public Hearing for the Proposed Landscaping Ordinance. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Proposed Landscaping Ordinance will be discussed by the Board at the next meeting.

Ms. Jethro discussed the Proposed Signage Ordinance.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to open the Public Hearing on the Proposed Signage Ordinance. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Dan Bazemore, Eure, discussed a sign that he previously erected. Ms. Jethro stated his sign would not have to be changed.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to close the Public Hearing on the Proposed Signage Ordinance. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept the Proposed Signage Ordinance as presented. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion. Commissioners Owens and Hora voted for the motion; Chairman Twine and Commissioner Jordan voted against the motion. The motion did not pass.

Ms. Jethro presented a Final Plat Review for Eastern Pride, Inc.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the Final Plat for Eastern Pride Inc. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to open the Public Hearing to rezone property for Eastern Pride, Inc. from A-1 to C-1. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Dan Bazemore, Eure, requested the Board approve it.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to close the Public Hearing regarding rezoning for Eastern Pride, Inc. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve rezoning from A-1 to C-1 for Eastern Pride, Inc. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to open the first Public Hearing for the CDBG-Scattered Site Grant for the Wooten Company. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Colleen Turner, on behalf of the Gates County Housing Committee would like to move forward with the four (4) sites chosen.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to close the Public Hearing for the CDBG-Scattered Site Grant for the Wooten Company. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

New Business

Chairman Twine read a Proclamation proclaiming March 2012 as American Red Cross Month. Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the Proclamation. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition. Chairman Twine presented the Proclamation to Carolyn Self, Executive Director, Greater Albemarle Area Chapter of the American Red Cross.

The Proclamation reads as follows:

PROCLAMATION**AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH 2012**

The American Red Cross has touched many lives in Gates County, as well as across the country and around the world.

During American Red Cross Month, we thank those who contribute to the mission of the Red Cross, whether through time, money or blood, and we invite others to support the Red Cross in helping people in need down the street, across the country and around the world.

The American Red Cross is synonymous with helping people, and has been doing so for more than 130 years. Throughout the past year, the American Red Cross launched hundreds of disaster relief operations in the United States to help people affected by fires, floods, hurricanes and tornadoes. Commissioner Owens made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to recess until 7:00 p.m. March 19. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.




