

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
APRIL 4, 2012**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, April 4, 2012 in the main courtroom, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Jordan, Hora, Owens and Jernigan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Commissioner Owens. Vice-Chairman Jordan led the pledge of allegiance.

Vice-Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Agenda**

Vice-Chairman Jordan stated the Agenda needed to be amended by the following: Hertford County Sheriff Juan Vaughan will be presenting a certificate to Sheriff Webb.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the amended Agenda. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the March 7, 12 and 19 Meeting Minutes as amended. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Hertford County Sheriff Vaughan presented a certificate to Sheriff Webb for completing the Sheriff's Leadership Institute.

Vice-Chairman Jordan discussed the new partnership with Hertford County to house Gates County's inmates since Chowan County has joined with the Albemarle District Jail.

**Citizens' Comments**

Anthony Felton, Eure, discussed the taping of Commissioners' Meetings by a private citizen during breaks in the meeting and posting false statements regarding him on a website.

Sidney Pierce, Hobbsville, republican candidate for Commissioner of the Hobbsville District, introduced Thomas Hill, republican candidate for Commissioner of the Sunbury District. Mr. Hill would like the Commissioners to take a hard look at considering ROTC at the high school. The County would be responsible for fifty percent of two teachers' positions; the ROTC position is fully funded by the US Dept. of Defense.

**Department Reports**

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 48-50.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to accept Budget Amendments 48-50 as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mrs. Pittman gave an update on the 2011-2012 budget deficits. Funds have been addressed and there is no longer a deficit. Funds are available to proceed with identified projects.

Colleen Turner, DSS Director, stated she would like to fill a part-time Office Assistant III position on a temporary basis.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to appropriate funds (\$5,000) for an Office Assistant III position for DSS to end June 30. Vice-Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion. Vice-Chairman Jordan, Commissioners Hora and Owens voted for the motion; Commissioner Jernigan voted against the motion. Motion carried by a majority vote.

Mrs. Pittman presented Budget Amendment 54.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve Budget Amendment 54 with a modification of an additional \$5,000. Vice-Chairman Jordan seconded the motion. Motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hora discussed the possibility of refinancing the USDA loan. Mrs. Pittman will return to the May meeting with the information.

Mrs. Pittman discussed the upcoming employee bio-metric screening. Commissioner Jernigan suggested the County Manager discuss the importance of the screening event with all employees, not just the department directors.

Commissioner Owens made a motion the bio-metric screening be mandatory for all employees who are available the day the screening is scheduled. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Administrator, presented the March Tax Collector's Report and an update on foreclosures.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to move forward with Zacchaeus Legal Services to collect taxes delinquent for two (2) years or longer. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Colleen Turner, DSS Director, stated Geoffrey Marett will be the new DSS Director as of April 19; May 4 will be her last day. Mrs. Turner presented the Gates County Community Child Protection Team and Child Fatality Prevention Team Annual Report.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to appoint Bobbi Lowe and Geoffrey Marett to the Community Child Protection Team/Child Fatality Prevention Team.

Mrs. Turner presented a Budget Amendment to the Home Community Care Block Grant due to allocations.

Vice-Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to amend the Home Community Care Block Grant as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented the Proposed Landscaping and Signage Ordinances.

Mary Lou Glennon, Hobbsville, discussed plants to be included and not included with the Proposed Landscaping Ordinance. She provided an invasive plant listing.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to have a special meeting with the Planning Board to discuss the Proposed Landscaping and Signage Ordinances. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Ms. Jethro discussed a request by Jeff Mitchell, a member of the Beaver Lake Ski Club. He has submitted building permits to construct three (3) of the six (6) cabins he received approval for in 2006, prior to zoning restrictions.

Chuck Brothers, Planning Board member, stated the Planning Board unanimously approved the request. Mr. Mitchell's request was a special circumstance due to the time frame.

Attorney Godwin states the current Board can write a letter to Mr. Mitchell stating the decision of the May 2006 ruling and due to an oversight at that time a letter was never written.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve moving forward with the six (6) cabins at Beaver Lake as authorized by the Board of Commissioners in 2006. A letter will be written to Mr. Mitchell stating any additional changes outside of the construction of the six (6) housing units he will be required to comply with current Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

#### **New Business**

Adrienne Bradley, JCPC Chairperson, presented the JCPC County Funding Plan and Program Agreement.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the 2011-2012 amendment as presented to the JCPC County Funding Plan. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the 2012-2013 JCPC County Funding Plan as presented. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

#### **Citizens' Comments**

Commissioner Jernigan stated citizens have contacted him requesting diagonal lines be painted in the parking areas near the tax/water payment drop box to signify no parking areas.

Anthony Felton, Eure, stated he is concerned about political signs being defaced or destroyed. Vice-Chairman Jordan stated political signs are protected by law.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter Closed Session authorized by NCGS §143-318.11(a)(3). Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Vice-Chairman Jordan stated the County Manager will move forward on the request made by the attorney and report the results to the attorney.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.


