

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 5, 2013**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, June 5, 2013 in the main courtroom, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Jordan, Owens, Hora, Jernigan and Hofler were present. Also present was County Manager, Jon Mendenhall.

Chairman Jordan led a prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the May 1, May 6 and May 20, 2013 Meeting Minutes as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Approval of Agenda

Chairman Jordan stated the Agenda needed to be amended by the following: Item 18 will be discussed in Closed Session authorized by NCGS §143-318.11(a)(1)(3); the new Item 18 will be Budget Amendment 57 and Item 19 will be Personnel Board recommendations.

Commissioner Hofler made a motion to approve the Agenda as modified. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Delegations – Unannounced

Thomas Hill, Corapeake, stated he has received comments from citizens supporting the renovation of the old courthouse. He stated if employees are appointed to the planning board they should act professionally. He asked Commissioner Owens, as Commissioner appointee to the Tri-County Animal Shelter Board, to discuss with him the Republican party's concerns with the animal shelter.

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, discussed the following: going forward with stabilizing the old courthouse, county water system leaks, HB769 (House Bill) and the Water Department budget.

Timmy Hedgepeth, Water Department Supervisor, stated he was concerned with budget cuts from the Water Department budget, specifically line items pertaining to water analysis, maintenance supplies and materials and general fund reimbursement. He would like to have the percentage charged to the enterprise fund to be reviewed.

Administrative Reports

Jon Mendenhall, County Manager, presented the May Administrative Report.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Administrator, presented the May Tax Collector's Report.

Old Business

Mr. Mendenhall reviewed the changes in the budget requested by the Board at the last meeting.

Commissioner Jernigan stated approximately \$208,000 has been put into debt services for use at a later date; \$50,000 was pulled at the first reading for redistribution. He feels funds are being pulled from departments to be put into debt services and the departments are being shorted. The departments need the money. He recommends pulling another \$50,000 from debt services; of the \$50,000 he would like to see \$25,000 added to the GITS budget and \$25,000 to the Water Department budget, specifically for water testing and quality.

After Board discussion Commissioner Owens made a motion to adopt the "changed" 2013-2014 budget as presented without further changes. Commissioner Hora seconded

the motion. Chairman Jordan and Commissioners Owens, Hora and Hofler voted for the motion. Commissioner Jernigan voted against the motion. Motion carried by a majority vote.

Chairman Jordan discussed appointments to various boards. Lessie Blow and Dan Askew have agreed to serve on the East Carolina Behavioral Health (ECBH) Board.

Commissioner Hofler made a motion Kathy Radmore, Dan Lang and Terry Eure be appointed to the Board of Adjustment as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Jordan stated four (4) applications have been received for the two (2) Planning Board vacancies. Commissioner Hofler nominated Phyllis Hobbs; Commissioner Hora nominated Ray Freeman and Commissioner Jernigan nominated Graham Twine.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to close the nominations for the Planning Board vacancies. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Jordan, Commissioners Owens, Hora and Hofler voted for Phyllis Hobbs to replace Lynn Hobbs. Commissioner Jernigan opposed. Phyllis Hobbs was appointed to the Planning Board to serve a three-year term expiring May 31, 2016, by majority vote.

Chairman Jordan, Commissioners Owens, Hora and Hofler voted for Ray Freeman to replace Rita Lane. Commissioner Jernigan opposed. Ray Freeman was appointed to the Planning Board to serve a three-year term expiring May 31, 2016, by a majority vote.

Chairman Jordan discussed a proposal for the new library dedication plaque.

After discussion Commissioner Hora made a motion to accept the library plaque as changed. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

New Business

Mr. Mendenhall discussed a request to surplus assets, a 2004 Bush Hog mower.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to approve the request to surplus the mower as presented. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented the following Budget Amendments: Budget Amendment 51, \$39,702.00, transfer Wastewater Treatment Facility Project funds from the original budget; Budget Amendment 52, \$16,368.00, final fire department payments for FY 2012 made during FY 2013; Budget Amendment 53, \$28,000.00, to reallocate budget for Water and Sewer Fund; Budget Amendment 54, to reallocate department budgets; Budget Amendment 55, \$15,700.00, to reallocate the budget for Solid Waste Fund; and Budget Amendment 56, to allocate merit increases budgeted including reclassifications in the Sheriff's Department approved July 1, 2012.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve Budget Amendments 51 – 56 as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Leah Craddock, Personnel Coordinator, presented a request to allow employees voluntarily and individually (at their own cost) to participate in the N.C. Public Employee Deferred Compensation Plan.

Commissioner Hofler made a motion to approve the Resolution, N.C. Public Employee Deferred Compensation Plan, Employee - Third Party Administrator Agreement. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution reads as follows:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Gates County, North Carolina wishes to provide a qualified defined contribution plan to the employees of Gates County; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina has established the North Carolina Public Employee Deferred Compensation Plan, a qualified governmental Deferred Compensation Plan under Internal Revenue Code § 457(b) for public employees of North Carolina; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Gates County, North Carolina, has adopted the North Carolina Public Employee Deferred Compensation Plan also known as "NC Deferred Comp" under the terms of the Plan Document and the Third-Party Administrator Agreement.

This resolution is effective upon its adoption this 5th day of June, 2013.

Mr. Mendenhall presented the revised 2013 Records Retention and Disposition Schedule from the N.C. Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and Records.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept the revised 2013 Records Retention and Disposition Schedule as presented.

Mrs. Pittman presented Budget Amendment 57 to reallocate the DSS budget for NCFAST equipment purchases.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to accept Budget Amendment 57 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Jordan discussed recommendations by the Personnel Board: Personnel Ordinance Item 6.13 Recognition of Service, text will remain as amended February 6, 2013. Renee McGinnis, Tax Administrator has reached the end of her salary range and is not eligible to receive her merit increase from her last performance evaluation. The Personnel Board recommends she be reclassified to a grade 25, step 13, on the new salary schedule.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to accept all recommendations by the Personnel Board as presented. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Citizens' Comments

Thomas Hill, Corapeake, voiced his concern regarding an item that will be discussed in Closed Session regarding Rev. Eric Earhart. He supports Rev. Earhart.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to enter Closed Session authorized by NCGS §143-318.11(a)(4) Economic Development, and (a)(6) Personnel. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to authorize sending the letter of recommendation for the citizen to the Governor as discussed in Closed Session. Commissioner Hofler seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to adopt the Resolution including Gates County in the Existing Foreign Trade Zone as discussed in Closed Session. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution Supporting Expansion of Foreign Trade Zones reads as follows:

GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
A RESOLUTION
SUPPORTING EXPANSION OF FOREIGN TRADE ZONES

WHEREAS, Foreign Trade Zones serve ports of entry throughout the nation as a tool for international commerce; and

WHEREAS, Foreign Trade Zones are intended to operate under the auspices of US Customs and Border Protection; and

WHEREAS, the benefit of Foreign Trade Zones are intended to lower the costs of U.S. based operations engaged in international trade and thereby create and retain the employment and capital investment opportunities that result from those operations; and

WHEREAS, the closest Foreign Trade Zone is FTZ #20: Suffolk, VA established for the Virginia Port Authority; and

WHEREAS, the proximity of Gates County to the Hampton Roads ports is beneficial to economic development;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Gates County Board of Commissioners supports efforts to be included in existing Foreign Trade Zones irrespective of state boundary and hereby directs the County Manager to advance, advocate, and extend in a cooperative fashion any expedient assistance necessary to accomplish inclusion in a Foreign Trade Zone in whole, in part, or in a subzone.


