

**GATES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
AUGUST 3, 2011**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday, August 3, 2011 in the main court room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan, Hora, Owens and Jordan were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell and County Attorney, Pitt Godwin.

A prayer was led by Rev. Wesley Boone. Commissioner Twine led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Agenda**

Chairman Twine stated the Agenda needed to be amended by the following: IV. A. 2. Lease Agreement for Child Support Services, 3. Amend the contract with Mike Scott; V. Sunbury Volunteer Fire Department request and there will be a Closed Session authorized by 143-318.11(a)(3).

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the amended Agenda. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve the July 6 and 18 meeting minutes as amended. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**Citizen's Comments**

Earl Rountree, Sunbury, stated Chuck Brothers or anyone has the right to call anyone they want.

Reba Green-Holley, Cooperative Extension Director, presented the Board with a copy of the books Clover all Over, North Carolina's first 4-H Century, 1909 – 2009 and Ordinary Women Extraordinary Service to Family, Community and North Carolina.

**Department Reports**

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 3-5.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept Budget Amendments 3-5 as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Renee McGinnis, Tax Assessor/Collector, presented the June Tax Collector's Report. She stated she will review the Sunbury School property and adjoining buildings that are currently on the market. The value is not correct with the property record card.

Gwen Harrell, Deputy Tax Collector, presented Requests for Refunds: Cindy Nicole Smith (Barber), \$102.49, and Kirk P. Cheatham and wife, Christy Cheatham, \$280.77.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to refund tax payers as requested. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Billy Winn, Emergency Management Director, discussed the receipt of surplus property, a 50 kw diesel platform generator and a module unit, from Verizon Wireless. There will only be a moving fee incurred by the County.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the surplus equipment as presented. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

**New Business**

Chairman Twine stated he received a request from the Sunbury Volunteer Fire Department for the radio tower located at the Sunbury School site.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to authorize the radio tower at Sunbury School to be given to the Sunbury Volunteer Fire Department. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Twine called the meeting to order after a brief recess.

Linda Hofler, Planning Board Chairperson, arrived late and requested to speak. Chairman Twine honored the request. She stated she was concerned with the letter the Commissioners had sent to a Planning Board member. She felt the Commissioners should have spoken to the member in person. She, as chairperson, is not aware of the Commissioners' goals, wishes, or visions in regard to planning, development and zoning. Planning Board members are concerned and want to represent the County.

Morgan Jethro, Planning Director, presented a request by Kim Old to rezone Tract 2 at Merchants Commerce to C-1. It is currently split zoned as R-1 and C-1.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to open the Public Hearing on rezoning Tract 2 at Merchants Commerce to C-1. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Dan Bazemore, Eure, stated he does not feel the sewer issue has been explained to the citizens. He requests the Board to keep the citizens informed; citizens would like to be informed for potential expenses that may be passed on to them.

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to close the Public Hearing for rezoning Tract 2 at Merchants Commerce. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the rezoning request as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Carolyn Morris, Community Development Program Administrative Agent, Albemarle Commission, presented the Update to the County's Fair Housing Plan, 08-C-1822.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the Update to Gates County's Fair Housing Plan, 08-C-1822 as presented with corrections. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Toby Chappell, County Manager, presented the Lease Agreement between LFM Properties, LLC and Camden, Gates, Pasquotank and Perquimans Counties for child support services for a renewal term of five (5) years.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the Lease Agreement as presented. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Chappell presented a contract for Grant Administration Services for the Economic Development Administration Grant Project with Mike Scott, Progressive Resources and Opportunities (PRO). Mr. Chappell will discuss the payment schedule with Mr. Scott and return to the Board with findings at the next meeting.

Kim Old, Merchants Commerce developer, presented a Phase I Completion Schedule.

**Commissioner Comments**

Commissioner Jordan discussed extending the contract with Chris Couch, Gates County Housing Committee Director.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to extend the contract with Chris Couch for two (2) months or until the Capacity Funding Grant is approved. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to amend his previous motion to state to extend the Housing Director's contract for two (2) months with County funds until the Capacity Funding Grant is approved and/or received. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hora asked for appropriations from the County to secure a database from Albemarle Regional Library, to be shared with each Commissioner, to be able to make a sound, logical decision regarding the new library.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to approve \$1500 from Fund Balance or wherever it can be found to purchase data from the Polaris Company, to gather data he will establish with Mr. Lytle from the Albemarle Regional Library database. There was no second to the motion, motion did not pass.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to forgo his salary to procure the database to present it to the citizens of Gates County, or whatever it cost the County. He will procure the database out of his funds. He will not be taxed or paid. The money will come directly from the County. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion pending the research for legalities, the motion carried without opposition.

The County Attorney declined opinion.

Mr. Chappell was asked by the Board to contact the School of Government regarding legalities and notify the Commissioners.

Commissioner Owens does not feel County funds should be involved.

Commissioner Hora does not want to be taxed for \$1500 at his rate.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to enter Closed Session authorized by NCGS 143-318.11(1)(3). Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Hora made a motion to exit Closed Session and enter Regular Session. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion that on Attorney counsel, recommends send the letter discussed in Closed Session. Commissioner Hora seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
